

Following our advice issued Monday 16 March, and in accord with the latest government requests and regulations on social/physical isolation and public gatherings related to the containment of the spread and rate of infection of the coronavirus, the Management Committee of Coffs Harbour U3A has decided that it has no choice but to cancel all its classes for Term2 2020.

That is, no Coffs Harbour U3A courses will be held from, Monday 27th April through until Friday 17 July, inclusive of those two dates. All classes for Term 2 have been cancelled.

We are hopeful, if not optimistic, that the situation will improve over the next 2 months if we are all able to follow the advice from our senior medical advisors and the virus is contained.
