Coffs Harbour U3A shutdown in accordance with Statewide lockdown

Members of Coffs Harbour U3A are advised that all courses will cease to operate from 5.00pm today, Saturday 14th August 2021. This shutdown will remain in place until the regional lockdown is lifted. This lockdown is scheduled to be lifted and we will advise members when that occurs..

The following list of applicable restrictions was available from one media source- take these as a rough guide, but if details are required check with updated Department of Health information, or with Services NSW.

Everyone must stay at home unless they have a reasonable excuse to leave. Residents cannot have visitors in their home from outside their household, including family and friends.

People still can have one visitor at a time to fulfil carer's responsibilities or provide care or assistance, or for compassionate reasons, including where two people are in a relationship but do not live together.

All hospitality venues must be closed to the public, including pubs, restaurants and cafes, except for takeaway.

Masks must be carried at all times and be worn when working outdoors, by school staff, people in outdoor markets, outdoor shopping strips, and in outdoor queues waiting for food and coffee.

Employers have also been ordered to allow workers to work from home, unless it is not reasonably practicable.

A one-day grace period for planned weddings and funerals in regional areas that have not already been subject to lockdown orders will be in place until 12:01am on Monday.

From Monday, attendance at funerals and memorial services will be capped at 10 people.
